Employees will know that they will be treated fairly and with respect and that they have the company's ethical standards to uphold. The community will know that the business is a good neighbor in every sense of the phrase. Thus there are many positive reasons for a company to "go public" with its commitment to good ethics. We need to look beyond ethics codes as a risk-prevention device. We need to embrace ethics programmes as a way to enhance the reputation of the business. This will contribute to longterm success and be of value to every stakeholder. It is a badge of honor and, by staying on the offensive, you will not be an attractive target for business critics.
